


How To Create a Math Recovery® Account & Register for a Course

HOW TO CREATE A MATH RECOVERY® ACCOUNT

- Go to www.mathrecovery.org
- Click on **LOG IN** in the upper right.
- Click on Create a Free Account.
- Enter in your email.



• If you enter an email that our system recognizes, you will receive this notification:


Having trouble logging in? Reset your password with the forgot password link or contact info@mathrecovery.org for account assistance.

- If you have had past participation with Math Recovery (including course or conference
 attendance, or orders in the on-line Store), enter your email and password associated with that
 past activity. If you can't remember your account password, we ask that you reset it using the
 "Forgot Password?" link. Contact info@mathrecovery.org if you have trouble accessing your
 past account.
- **IMPORTANT:** If you think you may have an account with MR associated with an old email that is no longer active, please **do not create another account** with your new email. Please contact info@mathrecovery.org and we will assist you with locating your past account and updating it.
- If you are new to MR, enter in your email and click **Get Started**. Fill in the fields and click **Get Started** again.



• Please write down your username and password for future reference. Again, if you forget your password, please **do not create a new account**. Click on "Forgot Password" and follow the instructions for reset.

• You will then see your Math Recovery® Dashboard under My Account.




BEFORE YOU CAN REGISTER FOR A COURSE

You need **two things** to successfully register for a course:

- 1. A Math Recovery® Account (instructions above)
- 2. A **Course Access Code** for the course. Access codes are provided by instructors **or** after payment is received. Contact orders@mathrecovery.org for more information.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR A COURSE

- Go to <u>www.mathrecovery.org</u>
- Click **LOG IN** (upper right-hand corner). Enter your username and password that you set up when you created your Math Recovery account.
- Click on the Courses tab in the top right.
- Use the drop-downs to search by the 4-digit Course ID Number, Date, Course Type, and/or State.
 Scroll down until you find the desired course. Click Learn More.



• If the course says, "Closed..." or "Not Accepting Out-of-District Participants," you will not be able to register for the course unless the course is being hosted in your own district. If you are out-of-district, you will need to search for another course that indicates "Open..." or "Accepting Out-of-District-Participants" (see images below). Course Details

Add+VantageMR® (AVMR) Course 1 is a four-day course that includes dynamic, diagnostic, individual assessments in number words and numerals, structuring numbers, and addition and subtraction strategies. The assessment, data collecting, and teaching tools accelerate the educator's ability to recognize the students' current levels of numeracy understanding to make data-driven instructional decisions. AVMR is beneficial for anyone working or supervising others in the area of mathematics. It is most appropriate for pre-kindergarten through elementary, as well as for middle school educators who work with students that have fallen at least two years behind standards. AVMR Course 1 is a prerequisite to AVMR Course 2.







- There is a 4-Step registration process.

 Step 2: Update Your Profile - Update/confirm your profile information. Be sure to update your School District name and contact information. Then click Save Changes.


