BEFORE YOU CAN REGISTER FOR A COURSE

You need **two things** to successfully register for a course:

1. A Math Recovery® Account (instructions above)
2. A **Course Access Code** for the course. Access codes are provided by instructors **or** after payment is received. Contact orders@mathrecovery.org for more information.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR A COURSE

- Go to www.mathrecovery.org
- Click **LOG IN** (upper right-hand corner). Enter your username and password that you set up when you created your Math Recovery account.
- Click on the **Courses** tab in the top right.
- Use the drop-downs to search by **date**, **course type**, and/or **state**. Scroll down until you find the desired course. Click **Learn More**.

Course Details

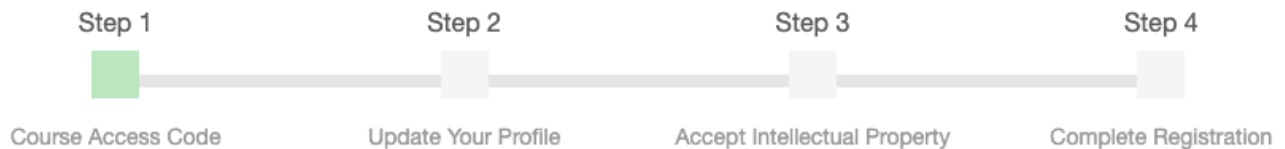
Add+VantageMR® (AVMR) Course 1 is a four-day course that includes dynamic, diagnostic, individual assessments in number words and numerals, structuring numbers, and addition and subtraction strategies. The assessment, data collecting, and teaching tools accelerate the educator's ability to recognize the students' current levels of numeracy understanding to make data-driven instructional decisions. AVMR is beneficial for anyone working or supervising others in the area of mathematics. It is most appropriate for pre-kindergarten through elementary, as well as for middle school educators who work with students that have fallen at least two years behind standards. AVMR Course 1 is a prerequisite to AVMR Course 2.

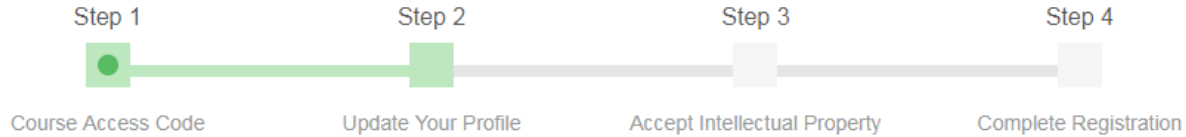
- There is a 4-Step registration process.

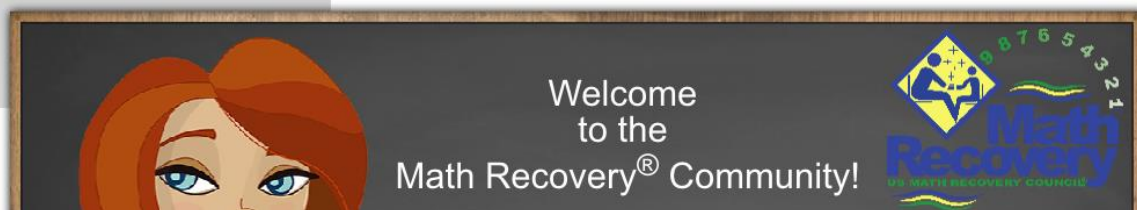

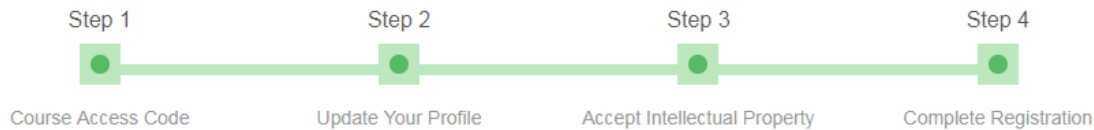
